



To host an inspection site you need to fulfill the following requirements:

1. Be able to board at least 5 horses or more and be able to board stallions! You have to expect a number of stallions for boarding. Box stalls and paddocks have to be in safe condition for all horses and people.
2. Be able to offer the Mare IBOP Test in riding and driving. This means you need to have a standard size leveled outside or inside riding arena and a leveled driving arena/field. To judge the horses at liberty you need to have a leveled, safe, fenced arena/ bigger paddock etc.
3. The site host is responsible for providing meals and for our judges and to transport them to and from the airport/hotel if necessary, etc.
(You can elect to split the cost for this among the horses at your site.)
4. The site host must also select decent accommodations such as hotel/motel or B & B closest to the Inspection site and submit the selection to the FHS for reservation and payment.
5. The site must have faxing capabilities and offer access to the Internet. The judges need power, along with a table and chairs placed at the arena where they are scoring horses.
6. Be able to help to get all the requested paperwork for all the horses together and mail out the judging reports to the FHS office after the judging is done.
7. It is recommended to have liability insurance so that you are covered if some unexpected accident happens on your property.
8. You must be a member of FHS in good standing.
