

To host an inspection site, you need to fulfill the following requirements:

1. Have stalls available for at least 5 horses or more and be able to have stalls that are suitable for housing stallions! You have to expect stallions that may be presented and so their stalls must be either separate from the other entries or constructed so that the stallions cannot interact with the other horses. Box stalls and paddocks have to be in safe condition for all horses and people.

2. If any entries need microchipping & DNA, a Veterinarian must be on call to provide this service on site. The entries needing this service would pay the veterinarian. The FHS office will notify you ahead of time if any entries need this service so that arrangements for a date and time can be made with the vet you choose.

3. Arena size: The arena needs to be level and minimally the size of a small dressage arena which is 20x40 meters (about 60.5x131.0 feet). It must be secure enough to have horses at liberty so the judge can evaluate the canter. It would also be used for the IBOP ridden tests.

The driving area can be anywhere that is level, does not have to be fenced, and should be minimally the size of a large dressage arena which is 20x60 meters (about 60.5x197 feet)

4. Be able to provide meals for our judges. (You can elect to split the cost for this among the horses at your site.)

5. Be able to transport the judges to and from the airport/hotel, etc. and provide the FHS Hotel lodging location information. (The FHS will pay for the judges' lodging accommodations)

6. Offer access to the Internet. The judges need power, along with a table and chairs placed at the arena where they are scoring horses.

7. The FHS suggests you have liability insurance so that you are covered if some unexpected accident happens on your property.

9. You must be a member of FHS in good standing.
