



Requirements for Hosting an Inspection Site:

1. Must be able to board at least 5 horses or more and be able to board stallions! You have to expect a number of stallions for boarding. Box stalls and paddocks have to be in safe condition for all horses and people.
2. Must have a Veterinarian available on site if any entries need microchipping & DNA and make sure you have an accurate instrument for measuring height. (No paper tapes or flexible instruments.)
3. Must be able to offer the Mare IBOP Test in riding and driving. This means you need to have a standard small dressage size leveled outside or inside riding arena and a leveled driving arena/field. To judge the horses at liberty you need to have a leveled, safe, fenced arena/ bigger paddock etc.
4. Must be able to provide meals for our judges. (You can elect to split the cost for this among the horse owners at your site.)
5. Must be able to transport the judges to and from the airport/hotel, etc. and provide the FHS Hotel lodging location information. (The FHS will pay for the judges' accommodations)
6. Must provide access to a printer and fax. The judges need power, along with a table and chairs placed at the arena where they are scoring horses.
7. Collect paperwork for all horses, including the Inspection reports and fax to the FHS office immediately after the Inspections are complete.
8. Must have and provide FHS office and Judges with a cell phone number that can be used for communication during Inspections and to coordinate with Judges activities.
9. Should have liability insurance so that you are covered if some unexpected accident happens on your property. The FHS is not responsible for any accidents or injury to persons or horses.
10. You must be a member of FHS in good standing.
